You might remember that we had two buses which the Diocese of Kafanchan had purchased. We loaded these buses with books, school supplies, medical supplies, bibles and spare parts and brought them to NYC to a pastor friend who then brought them to the port for shipping. They shipped around Sept 10th and arrived in Lagos harbor around October 20th, but could not get into port until October 29th due to the ongoing conflict in Nigeria. Once they were received in Lagos, they were moved to a safe location until Bishop Markus felt it was safe enough to move them to Kafanchan. Yesterday November 9th, drivers were sent to pick the buses up and happily I can say they have all arrived safely in Kafanchan (The Center) today.

Thank you to all who supported this ministry in any way!! Dattco, Inc of New Britain provided the buses for a very reasonable price and gave parts at their cost for future repairs. Many people donated cash to assist with the shipping cost. We had people who came to our home and helped pack the buses. And finally, two Dattco drivers drove the buses to the Bronx from our home.

Things like this do not happen without support, and we were blessed with all the support we needed!!
